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





## Current State of the Cessna Citation V Ultra Market

The retail sales activity with the Ultra is best described as steady so far in 2014. The same was said in 2013. There have been 31 retail transactions so far in 2014. If the sales activity continues as expected, the retail transactions for 2014 will be the same as 2013. There are just fewer than 12% of the Ultras listed for sale at this time. The inventory levels are still high with many choices for the Ultra buyer. Prices have remained steady all year. The average days on market are just over 200, which is about average for this vintage of business jet.

Most of the Ultras listed for sale are US aircraft. That is different than the late model Citation market where many of the used options are overseas. Interest in the Citation Ultra remains strong as many buyers like the value and performance capabilities of the Ultra. The only question we often get with an aircraft the age of the Ultra is avionics related. Buyers want WAAS and options for the upcoming ADS-B system. Support for the Honeywell avionics in the future is also a question. The demand rating for a good Citation Ultra would be a B-.











## **Current State of the Cessna Citation Encore Market**

The Encore market has been very active in 2014. If there is a strong finish in retail deliveries by the end of the year, the transactions could double the numbers from 2013. There are fewer than 5% of the Encores listed for sale at this time. The average days on market has dropped each year for the last three. With that increase in demand, prices have shown a slight increase. Encores in general are a niche aircraft with a smaller demand than the CJ2/CJ3 aircraft. The pricing on the Encores even rival an Excel in the same model years. If you have a good Encore, it will sell fairly quickly. The demand rating for a good Citation Encore would be an A+.











# Current State of the Cessna Citation Encore+ Market

There were 66 Encore+ aircraft built from 2006 to 2010. Very few have been resold yet. In 2014, there have been five retail transactions. Only two Encore+ aircraft are for sale at this time. If the Encore market is a niche, the Encore+ is a super niche. The average days on market for the Encore+ is low compared to the average in the Citation market. The demand rating for a good Citation Encore+ would be a B-.









# **Current State of the Cessna Citation Bravo Market**

The Bravo market has shown a strong increase in activity in 2014. Last year there were 33 retail transactions. There will be more than 50 in 2014. The average days on market has dropped over the last few years. With that increase in demand, we really have not seen a change in the retail sales prices for the Bravo. There are fewer than 9% of the Bravos available for sale. Roughly 40% of those aircraft are based overseas. Many buyers are looking for aircraft that are on an engine support program because of the high overhaul costs. The demand rating for a good Citation Bravo would be an A-.


