

Current State of the Hawker 800XP Market

The Hawker 800XP market rebounded in the 4th Quarter, with an increase to 12 retail transactions from 6 retail transactions in the 3rd quarter. The year ended with a total of 48 retail transactions as compared to 56 retail transactions for 2015. The average asking price has continued to decline from \$2.29MM in Q3 to \$2.175MM in Q4. There are currently 61 airplanes for sale or approximately 13% of the active fleet. We expect to see some stabilization in the H800XP market in Q1 2017, but for that to occur the H850XP and H900XP need to stabilize.







Current State of the Hawker 850XP Market

The Hawker 850XP market continued to be slow through Q4 2016 and there was only one retail transaction in Q4. This is the second quarter in a row with only one retail transaction. The year ended with a total four retail transactions as compared to 18 retail transactions for 2015. The average asking price dipped significantly in Q4 from \$4.2MM to \$3.87MM. There are currently nine aircraft for sale or approximately 8% of the active fleet. We expect Q1 to continue to be weak with continued pressure on values as the H900XP market and similar class of aircraft continue to decline.





Current State of the Hawker 900XP Market

The Hawker 900XP market has continued to decline and presents significant value for the capabilities of the aircraft. Pricing continued to drop in Q4 2016; average asking prices dropped from \$4.92MM to \$4.72MM. There was also a significant drop in retail transactions in Q4. There were a total of three retail transactions as compared to seven retail transactions in Q3 2016. There are currently 19 aircraft for sale, or approximately 10% of the active fleet. We anticipate some stabilization in the Hawker 900XP market in 2017, although at significantly lower values.





Current State of the Citation Excel Market

The amount of Citation Excel aircraft for sale has been trending down over the last two quarters. Roughly half of these aircraft are based in the US. There currently are not many choices in the domestic Excel market. The average days on market has also dropped in 2016 versus 2015. Citation Excels have been a traditionally strong market in the mid size category. Values are still dropping but not at the same rate as other mid size jet aircraft. The demand rating for the Citation Excel is B+.





Current State of the Citation XLS Market

Inventory numbers for the Citation XLS have remained relatively stable over the last four quarters, while retail sales activity has been fairly stable over the last year. 





Current State of the Citation XLS+ Market

The Citation XLS+ has the highest percentage of aircraft for sale in the Excel, XLS, and XLS+ product line. Most of these aircraft are based overseas. There are currently not many choices in the US for an XLS+. As compared to 2015, there was a sizeable gain in retail transactions in 2016. This makes sense as new aircraft owners reach the end of their depreciation schedule and are ready to upgrade. The average days on market have gone up significantly over the last four quarters. Citation XLS+ values continue to decline. The demand rating for the XLS+ is a C+.





Current State of the Citation Sovereign Market

Sovereign retail sales activity has slightly declined in 2016 as compared to 2015. The average days on market have had an increase also. There are good airframe choices available for sale in the Sovereign market. All of these trends will keep the values dropping for these Citations. We expect this trend to continue in the first half of 2017. The demand for the Sovereign is a B-.

Current State of the Citation X Market

This market is the most challenging of the larger cabin Citations. A large influx of early model year, former fractional aircraft currently available for sale is causing a decrease in sale prices in the Citation X market. We are also seeing an increase in the days on market. These factors have all contributed to a significant drop in aircraft values. The demand for the Citation X is a C-.






Current State of the Phenom 100 Market

The Phenom 100 market cooled off a bit during early 2015 and that trend continued through the first half of 2016 with ten retail transactions. The total of 20 transactions for the 2015 calendar year was down from the 26 transactions occurring in 2014. Sales activity this year is comparatively good with 28 transactions, up from 24 transactions in 2015. Inventory levels have dropped for the fourth quarter with 33 aircraft for sale, down from 39 at the end of the third quarter. Currently, 11% of the fleet is for sale. That number is down 2% from the end of the last quarter. About half of the Phenom 100s on the market are registered in the US. While prices trend slightly up, they have remained relatively stable compared to some models.











Current State of the Phenom 300 Market

As the model is becoming more established, the Phenom 300 continues to be a very successful aircraft for Embraer and the used market. After a slow start in 2015, the pre-owned Phenom 300 market heated up in the fourth quarter. Seven retail transactions during that historically active quarter brought the total aircraft traded in 2015 to 12, topping 2014's total of 10. For the first half of this year, activity has been good and 11 aircraft were sold through the third quarter of this year. Unfortunately, only two have sold in the third quarter so the recent activity is down. A strong rebound occurred in the fourth quarter and 19 aircraft were sold for the year. Inventory levels during the year bottomed out in the second quarter and then rose sharply to 40 units by the end of the year. Currently, 6.4% of the fleet is for sale. Prices trended down for the year with an average asking price of \$7.062 MM.





Current State of the Beechjet 400A Market

The Beechjet 400A fleet is 313 aircraft. Of the fleet, 47 were for sale at the end of the fourth quarter. This represents 15% of the fleet for sale. The Beechjet 400A market had softening values and slower transactions in 2015. Activity has been increasing over 2015 levels and ask prices appear to have stabilized for 2016. For the first quarter of 2016, there were 10 transactions compared to 10 in the first quarter of 2015, and 33 for the entire year in 2015. The second quarter recorded an additional 13 sales and the third quarter 12 sales, bringing 2016 total sales to 38. The Beechjet 400A continues to represent one of the best values in its class. With certified upgrades such as the Garmin G5000 avionics solution and the Elliott 400E program, there is clearly life left in this airframe. The Beechjet 400A market has been relatively stable and fairly predictable over the last year. The average asking price for a typical 400A is \$1.270MM, up from \$1.247MM last quarter. A premium continues to be paid for low engine and airframe times.







Current State of the Hawker 400XP Market

The Hawker 400XP activity for the first two quarters was very slow in 2016. Sales for 2015 were off by 20 units from the previous year, representing, a whopping 60% decrease in activity. Only three aircraft were sold in the first quarter of 2016 and none in the second guarter. However, in the third guarter, five 400XPs were sold, and in the last quarter, seven, for a grand total of 15 for the year. Inventory levels trended up throughout the year with a range from 19 to 23 units for sale at any given time and are now trending back down to 22. Prices for the 400XP remain extremely soft; as such, the airplanes are truly at bargain prices. You can expect ask prices to average \$2.193MM, up from \$2.163MM last quarter.






Current State of the Lear 45 Market







Current State of the Lear 45XR Market

The Lear 45XR market saw a decrease in the number of retail transactions in Q4 2016. There were a total of four retail transactions, down from seven retail transactions in Q3. The average asking price has dropped from \$3.97MM in Q3 to \$3.70MM in Q4 2016. We may have found the tipping point during the latter portion of 2016; the total number of transactions was 22 for 2016, up from a total of 10 in 2015. There are currently 25 aircraft available for sale or approximately 12% of the active fleet. 




Current State of the Lear 60 Market

Current State of the Challenger 605 Market


